**Books:** The library has a collection of ~ 5000 books to support the curriculum.

**New Books:** The library regularly receives new books; check the “new book” shelves.

### Electronic Subscription Resources

Searchable electronic resources are available. Millions upon millions of records are at your fingertips.

**LexisNexis:** LexisNexis is an online database of full-text US & international news, business, and legal publications: newspapers, magazines and journals, broadcast and political transcripts, polls and surveys, and individual college papers. Business resources include: financial data, company profiles, medical information, country and state profiles.



**WGSN Fashion Network** has information on the latest trends in the fashion industry. It's primarily focused on the fashion, design, apparel, style, and retail industries, with intersecting developments in consumer behavior, economic conditions and the environment. WGSN also provides career information, interviews with top-level buyers, fashion show information, worldwide events, and four million browsable images. Username/password in library.



**Encyclopaedia Britannica Academic**, the most well known and authoritative database around, is a great resource for finding brief encyclopedia entries on virtually any topic. It contains general information on various subjects: world data; an atlas; and an assortment of maps; biographies of famous people; news; classics; and much more.



**ProQuest Entrepreneurship** is a web-based database with a wealth of information on starting your own business, the study and practice of entrepreneurship, and business-related information. It offers market research, company profiles, how-to guides and forms for developing business documents, annual reports, conferences and proceedings, market research documents, full-text journals and magazines, video clips, and business dissertations.



**WWD.com**, the authority for news and trends in fashion, beauty and retail, includes headlines and breaking news from all WWD publications with comprehensive coverage of fashion week shows - New York, Paris, Milan and London.



**Atrium OPAC** is Wade College's own Integrated Library System. It allows searching the library's online catalog by author, title, and subject.



**Oxford Art Online** includes images of the most frequently studied works of art: access to 23,000 subject entries, 21,000 biographies, 500,000 bibliographic citations, 40,000 image links, and 5,000 images. Username/password in library.



**Homebuildlife** is WGSN's home & commercial design industry trend forecasting, product design, and development tool for the interiors market. Provides analysis, lifecycles, consumer insights and product reviews in 14 categories. Has images of 2D CAD designs, 3D furniture & lighting animation.



**CAMIO Catalog of Art Images Online** an image centered databases with 95,000 art images: photographs, paintings, sculpture, prints, drawings, watercolors, jewelry, costumes, textiles, and architecture — plus audio, video and mixed media. It provides access to decorative and art images from leading museums.
