In-House Materials



Books: The library has a collection of ~ 7500 print books and 35,000 ebooks to support the curriculum.

New Books: The library regularly receives new books; check the "new book" shelves.

WWD.com is the authority for headlines, breaking news, and trends in fashion, beauty and retail.

All WWD publications are included, providing full coverage of New York, Paris, Milan and London fashion weeks.



Atrium OPAC

allows online searching of the Wade College library catalog by author, title, and subject. Atrium includes ebrary and Berg Fashion Library titles and access.



ebrary's College Complete collection is a digital library providing 24/7 access to 35,000+ multidisciplinary e-books from leading publishers which can be viewed by multiple users simultaneously. Books are fully searchable and accessed through the Wade College catalog and can be downloaded for a 2 week loan period. Allows students to easily print, highlight, annotate, and obtain citations.



LexisNexis is an online database of full-text US & international news, business, and legal publications: newspapers, magazines and journals, broadcast and political transcripts, polls and surveys, and individual college papers. Business resources include: financial data, company profiles, medical information, country and state profiles.
